Personally came before me, a Justice of the Peace — in and for aforesaid County
and State, J. Walter Bradlee, aged forty-one (41) years,

a resident of the Town of Milton —, in the County of _____ and State of
aforesaid —, who being duly sworn, declares in relation to aforesaid case, as follows:

that I have known said Moulton, ever since his boyhood; know that prior to and up to the time of his enlistment in the Summer of 1862, he was in sound health; that I saw him immediately on his return to his home to Milton, after his discharge, in the Summer of 1865; that he then presented the appearance of a person much broken in health; he complained of chills or "shakes", trouble with his back and kidneys, and the result of a sun-stroke; he had headaches and a nervous twitching of his head, and very soon afterwards some affection of the eyes; that for about three (3) months after his return home he was unable to resume his work; during this period, and up to the time he removed to Somerville, in or about 1868, I was very intimate with him, resided near him, saw him weekly, sometimes daily, and know that he was occasionally, for a day or two, at a time, unable to attend to his business, on account of his troubles; that I have seen him occasionally, in every year since 1868 to 1882, and have known of the continuance of the symptoms above described from his appearance and his complaints to me as to his condition; that during the time when he was constantly under my observation, from the Summer of 1865 to about 1868, I should say that he was at least one half disabled for the performance of manual labor.

and I further declare that I have no interest in said case, and am not concerned in its prosecution, and am not related to said claimant.


