AUGUSTA, MAINE.DEC 5, 1904.Mr. Caroline S. Moulton,Wells, Me.Madam:—

The practice of requiring guardians and others receiving pension in a fiduciary capacity to account annually therefor to the Bureau of Pensions has been discontinued and replaced by the following requirement:

"Biennially every guardian or other person acting in a fiduciary capacity, receiving the pension of his or her ward or wards, will be required to file with the Pension Agent by whom the pension is payable a certificate of the court having probate jurisdiction, showing that the guardian or person acting in a fiduciary capacity has properly accounted to the court, as required by law, and that the account has been approved; or, in the event that the requirement of accounting has been waived, the certificate will show this fact, instead of that the account has been rendered and approved."

In conformity with this requirement you will cause the blank form on the reverse side of this letter to be properly filled, signed, and attested under seal by the clerk of the court to which you are accountable in the execution of your trust, and forward the same to this agency with your executed voucher for the pension due to MARCH 4, 1905.
