The agreement of association of a corporation which has no capital stock may omit the statement of the amount of the capital stock and the par value and number of its shares. The par value of the shares of its capital stock, if any, may be ten, twenty-five, fifty or one hundred dollars. The fee to be paid to the secretary of the Commonwealth upon the filing of the certificate of organization shall be five dollars. — REVISED LAWS, CHAP. 125, SECT. 3.
